MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR YOUR SAFETY AND PROTECTION

I. THIS IS NOT A PERMIT TO BURN: WHEN YOUR INCINERATOR MEETS THESE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS CONTACT YOUR LOCAL FOREST OFFICER FOR A PERMIT TO USE YOUR INCINERATOR.

2. BURN IN A SAFE INCINERATOR :* *(SHOWN BELOW IS A BARREL TYPE INCINERATOR, ILLUSTRATING MINIMUM FIRE SAFETY REQUIREMENTS. FOR OTHER TYPES OF INCINERATORS CON-TACT YOUR LOCAL FOREST OFFICER.)

HEAVY SCREEN MESH

NOT LESS THAN 14 GAUGE WIRE WITH HOLES NOT LARGER THAN 14".

METAL BARREL

IN GOOD CONDITION.

GROUND CLEARED

AND MAINTAINED AT LEAST IO FEET AROUND INCINERATOR OF ALL MATERIAL THAT COULD CAUSE YOUR FIRE TO ESCAPE. MORE CLEARANCE MAY BE REQUIRED.
