**\*\*You must have a burn permit to burn outdoors\*\***

## **Please observe these precautions when burning in a burn barrel:**

1. Always use an approved burn barrel screen
2. Never leave the burn barrel unattended
3. Always keep a charged garden hose close by
4. Never burn plastics, roofing material, rubber, etc. in your barrel (anything that produces black or noxious smoke is probably illegal)
5. Always keep your fire hot, so you do not have excessive smoke
6. **No** burning after dark

## **Please observe these precautions when burning debris piles or wood products:**

1. If pile is bigger than 8' x 6', fire department must inspect it before burning.
2. Never leave pile unattended
3. Always keep water and hand tools at the ready
4. Never burn plastics, roofing material, rubber, trash, etc. in your pile
5. Painted or pressure treated woods are illegal to burn
6. Keep fire small and hot to help minimize smoke
7. **No** burning after dark
8. Pile must be 20' from any structure

Burn permits are issued free of charge at the COCFRD main station in Waldport. Permits are good from January 1 to December 31 of the same year. Burn ban usually goes into effect on July 3<sup>rd</sup> and remains in affect until mid-October (usually). You must re-apply for a new permit every year either by phone or in person.

If we receive a complaint on your fire, your permit will be invalid until we make contact with the permittee and determine if the fire is a nuisance.

A courtesy call to the fire department is expected each day a new burn is set off.
